### COMMITMENT TO CLIMATE CHANGE

The company "Servicios Ambientales Rainforest del Ecuador" is an Ecuadorian company, a subsidiary of Rainforest Resources Inc; which is developing environmentally sustainable and socially responsible projects in different areas of Ecuador, the company firmly believes in the conservation of forests and their potential in the resources and services that nature offers us.

It currently has within its natural capital, 12,000 Ha of primary forest "Sumack Sacha Forest", located within the Sangay National Park, Province of Morona Santiago, which produces key environmental services for human well-being, since it contributes to climate regulation, they prevent natural disasters and allow the sustainable development of the non-forest use of the forest; promoting development in communities that press on conservation areas and negatively impact the stability of natural ecosystems.

This natural capital has a conservation priority because it is the fourth protected area with the highest water production in Ecuador (47.4 billion m3, Water Regulation Agency - SENAGUA 2007), in addition to having more than 3000 species of flora and 500 species of fauna. According to specialized studies carried out by the company, forest ecosystems retain and capture approximately 1'500,000 Ton / CO2 eq / year.

Rainforest of Ecuador subsidiary of Rainforest Resources Inc, is also framed in the 17 sustainable development goals proposed by the United Nations and is making strategic alliances with private companies that are committed to actions that mitigate and sensitize the problem of climate change as part of your socio-environmental responsibility; with this, these companies will contribute to offset their environmental impact regarding the carbon emissions generated by their commercial activities.
